

# SECTION 1 – NUMBER OF AVAILABLE PLACES

There are 12 places available for the 2021 academic year.

## **SECTION 2 – ENTRY REQUIREMENTS**

In order to attend the **Higher Education Programme – Contemporary Commedia dell'Arte Workshop**, a secondary school leaving certificate (e.g. high school graduation diploma) is required.

The following knowledge and skills are also required:

- good general knowledge;
- good command of Italian;
- good motor skills and coordination.

The above knowledge and skills will be assessed during the interview.

#### **SECTION 3 – INTERVIEW IN ITALIAN OR FRENCH**

Candidates are required to attend an **interview** as part of the selection process. Fully complete the application form where you will be able to choose an interview date, and send it by **30 June 2022** to **formazione@icraproject.it**. The application form is available on the web page of the Higher Education Programme.

The scheduled interview dates are: **6**, **7**, **8**, **14**, **15** July 2022. You will be notified of your interview time at a later date.

The interview will be held online via a video conferencing platform.

You will be notified of the outcome of your application within one week of your interview.

There are no tests or examinations.

#### REMEMBER

- It is essential that you complete the application form as fully and accurately as possible (name, surname, date and place of birth, and Italian tax code). **Check your e-mails regularly, especially after the application deadline**.

# SECTION 4 – OUTCOME OF YOUR APPLICATION

You will be notified on the outcome of your application as follows:

OFFERED A PLACE: You will receive an offer letter, the academic regulations, a copy of the coronavirus safety protocol and the COVID-19 self-certification form. You must enrol by 22 July 2022 or you will lose your confirmed place and will be placed on a waiting list.

**ELIGIBLE**: you are not admitted to the course due to the limited number of places available, but you will be placed on a **waiting list. You will be notified by 20 July 2022 if a place becomes available.** 

UNSUCCESSFUL: You did not meet all the requirements, but you can apply again next academic Winter session, scheduled for November 2022.

#### **SECTION 5 – ENROLMENT**

The tuition fee for the winter sessions of the Higher Education Programme – Contemporary Commedia dell'Arte Workshop €850.00 to be paid in two instalments as follows:

If you are OFFERED A PLACE, you must pay the first instalment of €500.00 by 22 July 2022 and the second instalment of €350.00 by 30 July 2022. All payment deadlines must be strictly adhered to.

- 1. copy of your bank transfer remittance;
- 2. signed copy of the academic regulations;
- 3. signed copy of the coronavirus safety protocol;
- 4. copy of your identification card or valid passport;
- 5. copy of your Italian tax identification code (*codice fiscale*);
- 6. a medical certificate attesting that you are fit and healthy and do not suffer from a heart condition;
- 7. **if you are a non-EU citizen residing abroad**, a copy of your visa **valid for the duration of the course.** For information on visas please visit the <u>dedicated website</u>

- 1. copy of your second instalment bank transfer remittance;
- 2. EU COVID-19 certificate;
- 3. certificate of a negative COVID-19 test;

# SECTION 6 - FINAL COMMENTS AND CONTACT DETAILS

#### A. FINAL COMMENTS

**COVID-19 certificate and self-certification:** prior to the start of the Masterclass, you are required to submit a **certificate of a negative Covid-19 rapid antigen test (nasopharyngeal swab) issued within the last 2 days prior to the start of the course – 30 July 2022 –** as well as the completed COVID-19 self-certification form, which will be forwarded to you with the admission form. These documents are required to participate in the course.
